Explanation of Benefits

The maximum benefit is stated on the front of your contract as either \$2,500 or \$5,000. The program has a two part benefit as detailed below. *The \$5,000 program is used for this illustration.*

Part 1 – Up to \$2,500 for reimbursement of the following items:

- Reimbursement for the insurance deductible
- Reimbursement for the sales tax and registration fees on the new vehicle (this reimbursement is contingent on purchasing a new unit)
- Reimbursement for towing expenses to replace your vehicle

Part 2 – Up to \$2,500 for payment towards a replacement vehicle:

- The payment is determined by subtracting the purchase price of the vehicle (not including taxes, fees, or any add-ons) from the amount paid by your insurance company prior to deduction for the deductible (since the deductible is paid in part 1 above)
